REDONDO BEACH PRESENTS THE BIGGEST SHOW IN TOWN!

REDONDO BEACH, Calif. – Now through April, the biggest show in town occurs daily at Redondo Beach, with the migration of the giant gray whale, truly one of the great sights of California. Redondo Beach offers a prime location to witness this impressive event.

The annual 14,000-mile migration starts in the Artic Circle and extends to the warm lagoons of Baja California, and back again to the Artic with newborn calves alongside. This migration is considered to be among the longest of any mammal in the world, and despite their enormous size, the giant gray whales apparently need little food or rest on their journey.

At Redondo Beach you can witness this magnificent spectacle, as the whales swim close to the Redondo Beach shoreline. On an escorted whale watching cruise, whales are often visible just five minutes from the harbor, and will sometimes swim to within a few feet of the boat. You will also be able to witness an astonishing diversity of marine life including playful dolphins, sea lions, harbor seals and pelicans.
