Redondo Beach Map is Made for Walking
New Map Takes Visitors on a Grand Tour of the City's Harbor & Pier

REDONDO BEACH, Calif. – If a map could tell a story of where there's More to Sea[®], it would speak of Redondo Beach's panoramic ocean views, restaurants with every variety of cuisine, the best recreation, ocean side hotels, entertainment, small boutiques and intimate cafes, shopping, sightseeing, and adventures. It's all featured in the new *Harbor & Pier Walking Map*, produced by the King Harbor Association and available throughout the King Harbor and Pier shops and stores, and at the Redondo Beach Chamber of Commerce & Visitors Bureau, 200 Pacific Coast Highway in Redondo Beach.

Visitors won't want to be without this colorful map, because it guides them from the Redondo-Hermosa bike path wall mural on Harbor Drive and Herondo Avenue, to the gateway of Riviera Village where vacationers have been known to spend half a day sipping cappuccino in a sidewalk café, shopping and people-watching. One of the most impressive features of the map is the tiny red hearts that indicate where all the heart-healthy activities are. The bike/walking path, which runs from South Redondo Beach to Santa Monica, is just one of them. The map key also features such cool icons as a camera that points out photo opportunities; running and walking paths; the "Path of History;" Public Art Display; GPS symbols that can be entered into navigation devices for ease of location; parking; rest rooms; biking; and other shops and businesses.

This handsome map shows four marinas - King Harbor, Portofino, Redondo Beach, Port Royal, and the Redondo Beach Pier, which feature many of the city's appealing visitor attractions. Most of the restaurants overlook the ocean, and almost any type of water sports can be arranged from rental shops. The map lists hotels, sites of interest, apartments, marinas, yacht clubs, shopping, and calendar of waterfront events.
