Where Gauguin escaped

Follow Paul Gauguin to the Marquesas Islands' spectacular French Polynesian scenery aboard the Aranui III adventure cruise. Half cargo boat, half upscale passenger vessel, the family-owned ship has been sailing to these islands for more than 30 years. This means the multilingual Polynesian navigators who guide you during this 14-day voyage know where Gauguin is buried, how to find hidden jungle ruins, how best to see wild horses and where the most impressive volcanoes, cliffs and waterfalls are. The itinerary is Papeete to Fakarava, Ua Pou, Nuku Hiva, Hiva Oa, Fatu Hiva, Tahuata, Ua Huka, Ua Pou, Rangiroa and back to Papeete. Departures are Nov. 23, Dec. 19, Jan. 12 and other dates in 2010. Starting at \$2,079 for shared, dorm-style accommodations and \$3,675 for standard double-occupancy accommodations (single supplement 50 percent), including daily meals with wine and most excursions but not including taxes and optional excursions. journey goes from Bamako to Segou, Sangha, Tireli, Douentza, Timbuktu, Essakane, Mopti, Djenne and back to Segou and Bamako. The dates are Dec. 30 to Jan. 15. Book by Nov. 15. The rate is \$4,995 double occupancy (single supplement \$495), including taxes, 11 nights in hotels, three nights camping, most meals, transportation in four-wheel-drive vehicles, the services of a tour guide throughout, admission to the music festival and airport transfers.
